2. Heads Livery conference 2020

The 2020 Heads Livery conference will be held on 3 March 2020. The programme is being developed at the moment. This will be the seventh annual conference in the series. It makes a really good opportunity for Livery members to talk to school practitioners and to hear about the priorities which schools have.

3. Livery Showcase

This is again being held as part of the City's summer careers event 'London Carers fair'. The Guildhall has been booked for the three days: Monday June 29, Tuesday June 30 and Wednesday July 1 2020. Apprentice 20 run by the Stationers Company will take place at the same time. This event gives an opportunity for the older students to meet employers.

LSL are planning to run the Showcase on two days. On one day, the audience will be from Years 5-6 in local primary schools. This proved to be very popular with primary pupils when we ran it for the first time last year. On the other day, the audience will be similar to previous years in that years 8 and 9 students from secondary schools around London will be invited. The Showcase gives an opportunity for students to be made aware of the wide range of opportunities available as they start to plan their own career journey.

We do not yet know the actual dates on which the different events will take place but it would be good if the people in your Company who run your stall at the Showcase can make a note of the three dates at present. Maureen Marden from LSL will be in touch about booking stall holders.
